

How To Purchase a Season Pass

Visit <u>https://calabogie.axess.shop/</u> and click 'Buy A Season Pass' from the Homepage.





Use the drop-down menus to select the type of pass you would like. 'Weekday Season Pass' is for our Almost Anytime Pass. All other pass types (Adult, Child, Student, etc) can be found under 'Season Pass'.

- Transfer out of the region due to employment (greater than 250 km from Resort)
- Loss of Job
- Government Mandated Closure due to COVID-19
